COURSE OVERVIEW

 This qualification reflects the roles of community services, case management and social housing workers involved in the managing, co-ordinating and or delivering of person-centred services to individuals, groups and communities.

- At this level, workers have specialised skills in community services and work autonomously under broad directions from senior management. Workers are usually providing direct support to individuals or groups of individuals. Workers may also have responsibility for the supervision of other workers and volunteers and or case management; program coordination or the development of new business opportunities.
- The course is fully accredited nationally recognised training.



AUSTRALIAN COLLEGE OF SKILLS AND EDUCATION

COURSE ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

- There are no formal entry requirements for this course.
- Prospective learners are expected to be able to pass a Language, Literacy and Numeracy assessment to determine their ability to enrol in the program.
- The program does not require you to have any pre-existing computer or technology skills.

DURATION & STRUCTURE

- The duration of the course is 12 months self-paced, including all learning and assessment activities. However, it is anticipated that the course length will vary with regard to individual client's level of expertise and time dedicated to study.
- As a guide, given the total number of units in the program is 16, students should aim to complete and be assessed in 1 unit every 3 weeks. To do this, students will be required to study at least 12 hours a week or 48 hours a month.
